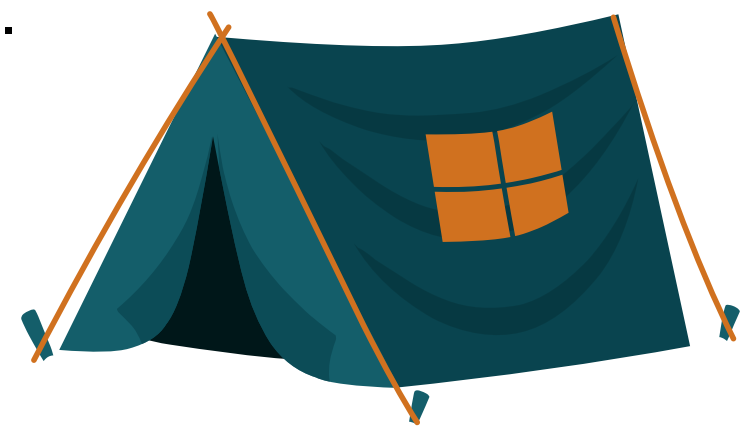
### CAN YOU HELP US DRY OUR TENT?
